Bard doesn't let you save a response within Bard, right? It has to be copied and saved somewhere else?	No - only ChatGPT does. Bard is just a list, and if you leave the conversation, you lose the response.
Any word on when Google Classroom is releasing the ability to have quarters?	They've been testing grading periods (configurable) but who knows when they will get it into release (not for fundamentals tho, only paid tiers) (we were in the beta program)
