The SHSM Program:

The Specialist High Skills Major - Sports Program includes the following components:

-A specific bundle of 9 credits of Grade 11 and 12 credits including:

- 4 'Sports Major' credits (one must be in gr.12)
- 3 required credits (includes Math, English, and one 'Other' course)
- 2 Cooperative Education credits (minimum)
- 6 Sector-recognized certifications and/or training courses

-Experiential learning activities within the sector

-'Reach Ahead' experiences connected with the student's chosen post-secondary pathway

-Development of key essential skills and work habits required in the sector, and the use of the Ontario Skills Passport (OSP) for purposes of documentation.

The Selection Process

SHSM is for everyone! However, because this is a Ministry of Education program with rigorous requirements, we want to ensure that our SHSM students will be successful. Therefore, successful applicants will be selected based upon the following criteria:

- Relevance of student academic, personal, and/or career goals
- Consultation with SHSM Lead Teacher, Guidance Counsellors, and/or Administration
- Commitment to taking 2 credits or 4 credits of Cooperative Education

It is strongly recommended that applicants and their parents consult the Lorne Park Secondary School SHSM Course Planning Guide during the grade 10 course selection process (December-January).

This will ensure that students are fulfilling their SHSM course requirements in Grade 11.

Successful applicants will be notified and will meet with a guidance counsellor to adjust course selections if necessary.
