 Artists use the elements and principles of art (such as color, line, value, texture, shape, and form) to express their ideas. Artists make art through a process that often involves planning and reflecting. Artists take care of art tools, materials and the studio environment. Artists practice skills and techniques to improve their artwork. Artists choose specific techniques to express their ideas. Artists explore materials and techniques to find ideas and new ways of working. Artists look closely at their own work, the world around them and the work of other artists. Artists visualize ideas before and during the process of making art . Artists express ideas, stories or feelings through their artwork.
