Time Trials- This Weekend!

Time Trials are this weekend and we are so excited! Below is the lineup for the event. Let us know if you have any questions at broadstone.barracudas@gmail.com. Job sign-ups have been posted so please sign-up if you have not done so already. For the new swim families- if this is your first time you've been to a meet, it

may be a bit overwhelming! If you have questions during the meet, feel free to ask the board members, other parents, volunteer coordinator (located at the volunteer check in tent) or the swimmer check-in crew.

Meet Lineup for Saturday, May 6, 2023 Time Trials:

Where: Broadstone Sports Club

Who: Broadstone Barracudas Swimmers only. This is not a dual meet.

Timeline:

6:30-7am - Check-in for swimmers and volunteers

7-7:45am - Coaches Scratch Session (where the coach crosses out all swimmers that have not checked in)

7-7:45am - Approximate time for team warm-ups - listen to the PA system for age group announcements

8am- 1:30pm - Swim meet (ending time may vary)

Check-in: The check-in table will be located inside the large gate in the parking lot (between the tennis court and the building). All swimmers AND volunteers must check in by 7am. Simply put a checkmark next to your names. Any swimmer not checked in by this time will be scratched (removed) from time trials.

Volunteers: Please show up for your job. When you check-in please ask the volunteer check-in tent for any important directions for your job. If you are a PM job please listen for calls over the PA system for when/where you should report for your shift.

Family Set-up: Upon check-in at 6:30am you can begin setting up. Pop-up tents are ONLY allowed on the back lawn.

Events: Swimmers will compete in ALL events that they are eligible to swim in for their age group. No relays at time trials.

Junior Barracudas Is Back!! Start This Week!

Junior Barracudas registration has started back up this season! This year for the **FIRST TIME EVER** you do **NOT** need to be a member of Broadstone in order to do the Junior Barracudas 3-week class in May and June. So, if you have a friend that is interested in doing Juniors with you but they are not members you are welcome to invite them along. This swim program focuses on freestyle, backstroke and diving skills designed to prepare children for the Broadstone Swim Team. Instruction is done in the water with the children. Swimmers must be ages 4-7 and be able to swim independently without fear of the water. It is imperative for the safety of our swimmers that participants are water safe and ready to learn. The club offers other programs to prepare children for confidence in the water. Children may also participate in home Barracuda swim meets when the coach determines readiness. Parents will be asked to provide goggles and fins for their child. Details will be given at the first class meeting. This program costs \$140.

Session 2: June 5-29: Mon, Wed, Thursday from 5-5:30pm

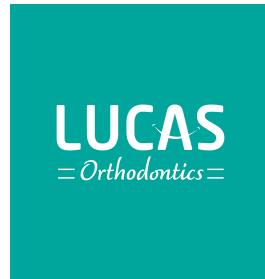
