# Sophie Stardrop

## Who is Sophie & her first video

Sophie Stardrop is a "game director" of her upcoming game called **Heartstrings**. In the past she used to upload Stardew Valley YouTube shorts which are now private. She started her project by making a video which was a proposal for a new Yansim game.

To explain why people are suddenly making Yansim games, we have to talk about Yandere Dev, Alex. Alex has been working on this game since 2014 and still hasn't finished it. During covid Alex received a lot of backlash for not finishing Osana, which is the first rival. Due to this backlash Dr.Apis showcased his Yansim, which later fell apart as he was exposed.

People were tired of Alex's laziness so they wanted to do it by themselves. However in recent years he has been exposed for grooming. Which was another factor. A lot of YouTubers stopped making videos on Yansim due to this. And because of that a lot of people want to work on a Yansim game.

Of course there's nothing wrong with making a Yansim game, but rather than proposing it, just show us the work you made for the game. Which is what Sophie didn't do. Sophie in her first video spoke about her concepts, which reminder, can change anytime. Not showing any work and only concepts makes it hard to trust the project. As it's only words that can mean absolutely nothing. You cannot just introduce a product with only concepts and no actual game. What are we supposed to expect if we only have concepts and no functional game that shows us the product. Games get revealed once the game is at least playable in some way.

However there's more in Sophie's first video that makes the project less trustworthy. During the video, she stated that no money equals no game. Which raises a question, is this even a passion project?

People make games for passion not for money. And if Sophie only wants to work on the game for cash there's a risk that the game will get canceled. So you threw your money to her for no reason.

### Yansim shit talk

During this, she started to upload videos on Yandere Sim where she was trashing the game. There's nothing wrong with such, but Sophie is working on the same game. It makes it look like she made the game out of spite. The way she's quote on quote "criticizing" the game made her look very narcissistic, making her look like she "knows better". We barely got any news regarding her game. So you can probably make up what that made her look like.

In every single video she calls herself in the description a developer. She is not the developer, she's the game director. So, who's the developer? Her husband. Now, I didn't bring him up earlier because he wasn't important until now. Her husband is a programmer. She stated it herself and even said he can code with HTML (website programming language). Sophie has no experience with coding, so her calling herself a developer is misleading.

If you are curious, there is a difference between developer and game director. A game developer is the one who's creating it and making it a reality. Programmers specifically. And a game director is the one who creates the story, concepts and much more. Which matches Sophie very well.

Let's talk about her experience. She can draw, however she has no experience with game direction. There's nothing wrong with having no experience, but she chose the worst project for such. Yansim game is a hard

genre to make especially if you have no idea how to direct it. She clearly doesn't know what she's doing as she made the main character a psycho. Not a yandere but a straight up murderer.

A lot of people might have a different opinion regarding this, but I'm saying this because I experienced it.

When I was 11, I was working on a Roblox Role-playing game. A genre that is actually difficult to make. No experience with game direction. At that time it was a passion project which then became a game made out of spite. I hated Animatronic World. Because of that I fell into the dark and started to steal assets. During that I got burnt out and kept canceling the game. In recent years (2023-2024) I canceled it and wanted to completely forget it.

No experience, failed hard, had dark times and barely knew what I was doing. I learnt from these mistakes and got better. I worked on multiple projects which kept getting canceled, until I created Good Work. A small game. Small tycoon game that had the concept since the start. The development is going smoothly.

If Sophie truly wants to do this, she should have started small, not big.

## Money issues

Sophie stated to me that they live off donations from the Ko-fi. Which is a really huge red flag because if that's all you get, there's no way you'll be home for long. She also stated that the Yansim videos are made because she needs the YouTube revenue. That doesn't excuse her


I'm going to ignore Matthew, since it's clear they don't understand that I can't pay rent or food with only 25 dolars (which is what we gained in donations last month)

Her first public game build is very underwhelming. It barely has the mechanics a Yansim game needs. Especially if it was in development for 2 months. This looks more like a week's progress or a month. This means that this game is going to take ages to finish. Her second game build is slightly better but it still doesn't have everything. The male elimination is lazy. Not replacing the death animation for the male is lazy especially if you literally added them.


The upcoming UI isn't great either. Too big, looks weird, inventory on the left for no reason, telling us the weather for no reason and probably much more.

She actually did change this recently, but she still didn't change it for the last subscription. She didn't apologize either. If you're promising something that isn't even true you should apologize.




# The false sabotage

Recently, someone on CharChar's YouTube video mentioned that Sophie used to do Spanish videos as a VTuber.





And sounds like Sophie. <u>There's another channel that is based off LoL (League of Legends)</u> and it has a description url that leads to the now deleted <u>Twitch Account</u>. Cherilú has a <u>community post of a ginger cat</u>, and who has a ginger cat? That's right, Sophie.


Because Sophie never showed the face of the cat it is hard to tell if it is the same, however both are green eyed (She drew the cat with green eyes).

#### Questions:


- 1. Since you were Sophie's manager, how did you become one? Are you a part of the Owozu company?
- 2. Why was she fired from NoriVT? Was it because of her mental instability?
- 3. Has she ever said that she is struggling financially?
- 4. If she didn't pay the PC, why didn't Owozu take legal action?
- 5. Are the other channels a part of Owozu?
- 6. Someone on reddit said that as CherryCraft she participated in harassment campaigns against another vtuber named FuelVt, do you know anything about this?
- 7. Was there any drama with her?

#### Answers:

- 1. He has been a manager for the company for a while. They then later made the agency and Sophie got in as Nori.
- 2. She has been fired due to her behaviour. She broke the contract several times and they had to cancel the graduation (graduation is when a Vtuber leaves) because she was threatening them with suicide. The suicide never happened. He has also stated that she's a paranoid schizophrenic. Apparently she had episodes in which she talks of being harassed by dead people.
- During her job, she was paid well and she was earning enough to live for a YEAR. She's struggling now because she has no job. She tried to work with MC Youtubers but failed.
- 4. She didn't pay the PC, there was a whole different contract for it. She was supposed to pay but she got away. She got away with it because she escaped to Columbia, to her husband. Because of that she cannot be sued as she "doesn't" live there. (Chile).

After that, they went back to Chile. Her husband is an illegal migrant.


Her husband entered illegally which is why he cannot work. The Ko-fi trip caused that. You helped her to get the paperwork to make it legal.
