First 10 minutes

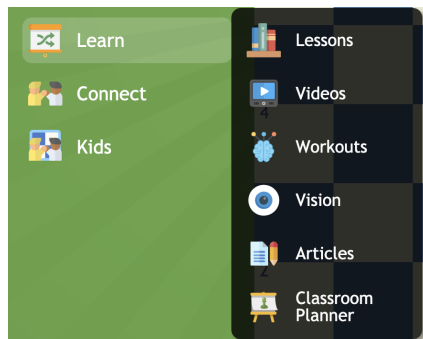
Introduction activity: everyone will tell their name, age or grade, and something they did this summer!

Day 2 - The Rules and Checkmate

First 10 minutes

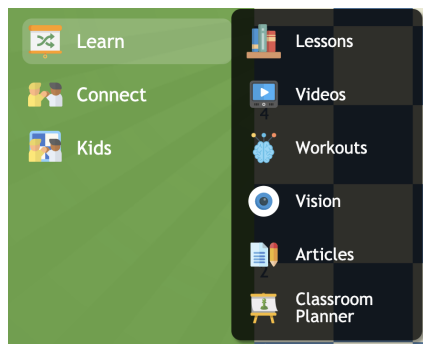
Introduction activity: Any questions, and discussion of the homework.

We will look at the 3 main rules: check, checkmate, and stalemate!

Homework

Each student will complete the lessons: check-to-stalemate.

Day 3 - Unique Moves

First 10 minutes

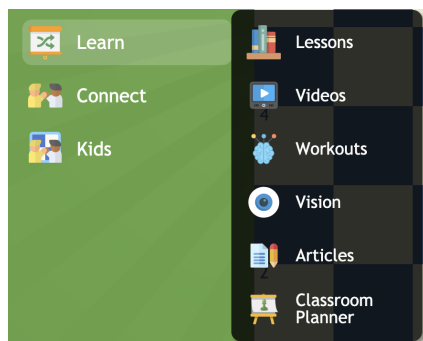
Introduction activity: Any questions, and talking about any hard parts of yesterday's homework.

Rest of class

We will begin by a few custom positions that I have made. Each student will privately tell me the best move through the chat for each position based on yesterday's homework. After each student has responded, I will explain the correct answer to the whole class. Next, I will talk about king and queen checkmates.

Homework

Each student will complete the lessons: castle-to-back rank mates.



Click learn > lessons

Each student must do all of the lessons till they reach special pawns. Do not finish the lesson, just stop once you reach it. This includes a video and a quiz per lesson Then they must go to



And do the top two workouts: the rook roller, and the queen and king.

Day 4 - Starting Chess Games

First 10 minutes

Introduction activity: Any questions, and talking about any hard parts of yesterday's homework.

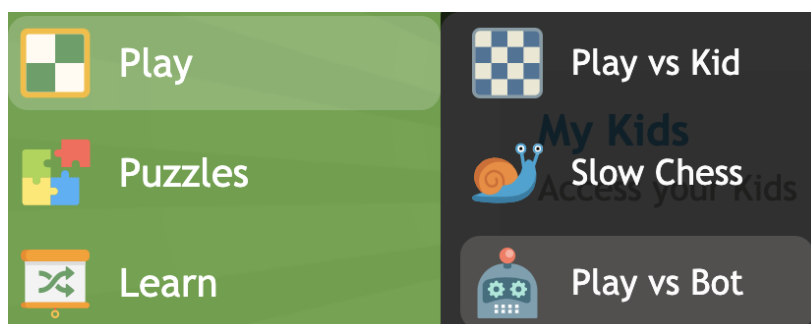
Rest of class

Homework

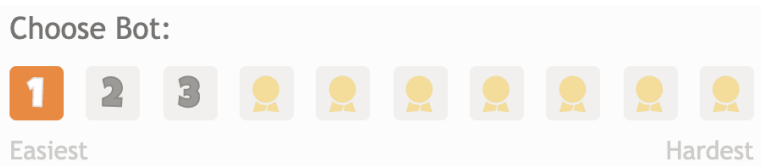
Each student will play 2 online games with a robot
