### Called Meeting to Order/Welcome/Happy New Year: Amanda Durkin

## **Principal's Report:** Mr. Nathaniel Barnes

- 1) Updates:
  - a. School Start Times
    - i. Official Vote takes place in February
    - ii. CP times would be 8:15am-2:30 pm
    - iii. Details in Eagle Eye this Friday, 1/17
    - iv. Videos pertaining to start times posted on District website
    - v. 800 survey responses already
    - vi. Voting will determine when information about time change will/can be shared
  - b. Capital Project
    - i. Lights taken out were done quicker than expected, ahead of schedule
    - ii. Air quality tests done before students and teachers return after breaks/during work to ensure health and safety of the school

### **Guest Speaker:** Mr. Barnes, New CP principal

- 1) **Question while set-up is happening**: What is your favorite thing about CP so far? Answer: the students!
- 2) PowerPoint presentation is posted online on the CP PTA Home page: <a href="https://www.countryparkwaypta.org/home">https://www.countryparkwaypta.org/home</a> Click on Mr. Barnes introduction presentation
- 3) Specific details given based on the introduction presentation are below:
  - a. Who is He? Loves gummy candy, Pepsi and chocolate
  - b. Why? Wants to learn CP's ways and ask questions, he is here to support the school community as a whole, not just academics
  - c. What? Will learn CP "through and through", has been asking teachers: "We are CP!" What does that mean to them? Will attend CP functions, part of being a family.
  - d. When?
    - i. Wants to be sure practices align with approach to teaching at CP
    - ii. Data driven changes, if any, would be implemented in 2025-2026
    - iii. Will ask a lot of questions to get to the deeper meaning, follow-up lines of questioning
    - iv. Changes will not up-root systems in place at CP but potentially the approach of how to get there
  - e. Promise: Safety first, Learning, Communication, Collaborative environment
  - f. Soon to come: Facebook Reading Initiative, engage virtually, includes students as a collaborator in their school
  - g. Thank you, all stakeholders, for welcoming me!
- 4) **Questions posed from the PTA website** <u>Abbreviated</u> <u>questions/answers below:</u>

**Question:** How will you ensure that all things CP are working well and remain so? Can you give us reassurance that strengths for our school/teachers will not be changed for the sake of change? Will stakeholders be given a chance to voice concerns if changes are coming?

**Answer:** Principals job to introduce schedule, align all things within grade levels, CE, etcetera. Scaffolding will be put into place to ensure support for all areas and all students. Implement a way for feedback to be given.

**Question:** How will you ensure and foster that our teachers stay a tight-knit family and ensure a good working relationship with them?

**Answer:** Ensure there are systems in place to continue collaboration which can foster familial relationships. Meet with teachers on Fridays to ask questions to learn how things are done. Setting up Norms/Expectations. Daily messages from me to the staff, not always strategic, can be personal. Show up at events, like family would. Will do shout-outs to teachers from other teachers. Ask myself: what should I not do to keep CP great?

**Question:** What will you do to keep CP consistent in its culture, community involvement, and achievements?

**Answer:** (repeat of some of the above). Plans to introduce celebratory items and achievements. Recognition of work done.

**Question:** Top 3 Goals for Country Parkway?

### Answer:

- 1. To get to know students
- 2. Earn National Recognition (Blue Ribbon status?) based on the achievement already happening here, this leads to offering other resources for the school
- 3. My being here adds to the experience and community of CP

**Question:** What are some things from your previous school you would like to implement here? **Answer:** Reading initiative (described above). Parent/student date night: dressed up affair, formal dinner, ballroom dancing lessons, dance party. It's a way to build community and character.

### **Open Forum/Questions:**

- 1) Jeanette Robe: PTA Bowling/Raffle event coming up on March 2<sup>nd</sup>. Details coming soon.
  - a. *Question*: How do the baskets work? Room Parents received notice about them but as a kindergarten parent, I don't know what that means. *Answer*: A sign-up genius will be sent to Room Parents with ideas for baskets. You can choose. Room Parents can ask for donations from the classroom families or community.
  - b. *Question*: Would it be possible to clarify to families know that it's mostly the kids that bowl, not parents? *Answer:* Of course!
