

Uniform Guidelines and Expectations

School uniform expectations are high and wearing the Kennedy School uniform proudly is part of being a member of the community. All students are expected to be wearing their Kennedy School uniform with pride each day and this includes appropriate footwear. All students are to be in proper uniform (as outlined below) from Monday 27 February 2023.

We will prompt the children with a verbal reminder and then send a letter home if this continues so that you are aware and can help make the change to meet the Kennedy School uniform guidelines.

Please be reminded of the following standards expected daily:

 Sturdy black leather style school shoes are to be worn with the school uniform





- Black trainers, canvas sneakers or ankle boots are not to be worn with the school uniform.
- Socks grey or white should be worn.
- Trainers should be worn with PE kit.
- No undergarments should be showing (ie long sleeved vests).
- Hair ties and accessories are to be either purple, grey or black.
- Jewellery should not be worn to school, with the exception of watches and small stud earrings. If your child wears a watch that receives calls or notifications, it must be disabled during school hours.
- All students are expected to have a school hat and a raincoat. Please do not pack umbrellas.
- An ESF school bag or a KS/ESF school bag is preferred for your child.
