LOCATION FACTORS

What are the factors that determine where a person will choose to locate?

- **CLIMATE:** People wish to live in an area that is favourable (not too hot, cold, dry or wet) and climates that are suitable for growing food.
- **PHYSICAL LANDSCAPE:** People tend to settle in areas that are <u>flat</u> and suitable for <u>agriculture</u>.
- **WATER:** People usually settle near water, which is used for recreation, <u>transportation</u> of goods, farming and industries. It is also essential to life!
- **RESOURCES:** People like to settle where there are <u>natural resources</u> (oil, wood, fish, etc)
- **POLITICAL:** People like to settle in areas that have <u>stable governments</u> (safety).
- **SOCIAL/CULTURAL:** People tend to settle in areas where there are <u>family</u> or similar <u>ethnic groups</u>, as well as in areas that are <u>not isolated</u>.
- **ECONOMY:** People prefer to settle in areas where there are many <u>jobs</u> available and opportunities to make <u>money</u>.
- **TRANSPORTATION:** People tend to settle close to areas that offer good transportation services (<u>major highways</u>, bus services, etc).
- **SERVICES:** People tend to settle in areas where there are many services (grocery stores, entertainment activities, hospitals, schools, etc).
