#### **SCHOOL DANCE 11/6**

### **REPEAT POST: DANCE RULES**

- Only DGSN Students: No Siblings or students from other middle schools.

# DPS PREP LEAGUE - VOLLEYBALL REGISTRATION OPEN

Boys and Girls Volleyball registration is now open. DGSN has not had a boys team in the past, but Coach O'Toole will be coaching both teams if we have enough players. Per DPS requirements, all students must be registered through Arbiter Sports before trying out for any sports. You will have to pay a registration fee of \$36 (\$26 for students who receive FRL). If your student ultimately does not make a team, you will be reimbursed for that payment after tryouts. The DPS Foundation has acquired the My <u>Spark Denver</u> program, which gives eligible families \$1,000 per student on a restricted My Spark Card, allowing them to choose afterschool and enrichment activities. #### TRIMESTER 2 ELECTIVES START MONDAY

Some students will change electives on Monday for trimester 2. Our scheduler, Ms. Tina, did a great job making our schedule for trimester 2. Each student took an elective preference form and we worked hard to follow-up with students that did not. Her method is to first find everyone who did not get their top elective choice in trimester 1, and make their schedule first so they can have a better chance of getting their top choice. Then she begins assigning electives based on preference and in trimester 2, everyone got either their first or second choice. In looking at the data, PE and gardening were the top two elective choices, and had a higher chance of someone putting number one and not getting it. Students were told how to view electives using this clickpath.
