The Swami's Northern Canada Results

Featherweights



Miley Cyrus 33-11 (Badass Barbies) vs Audrey Alleen Allen 35-14 (Centerfold Angels)

Lightweights

Welterweights

Middleweights

Zara, though title-less, faced Kendall in a prior event, fostering confidence to dethrone her former ally. 




Kylie Jenner 33-12 (Badass Barbies) vs Victoria Silvstedt 31-14 (Centerfold Angels)
