What does Worship look like with the kids?

Our typical rhythm is to jump into worship right after the Witness story (so 10 mins into the session). We usually sing 2 or 3 songs (just over 5mins) with lyrics either taught in 'repeat after me' format, shared on the screen or written on poster board. Leaders can play instruments, use videos or teach with just voices. We're open to whatever your gifting is!

Why is Worship so important?

Worship provides a space to pour out praise to God and to receive His truth. <u>And kids love to learn through music!</u> Melodies help teachings root themselves inside our hearts - for years to come the lyrics they learn will shape their walk with Jesus.

Who are we looking for?

If you can play the guitar, the cajon or just hold a tune - join us! It's an opportunity to share your musical giftings with the next generation. We love stripped back worship - we're not a big production!

What songs to bring?

We sing a range with the kids! From old school classics (like Peace Like a River and Father Abraham) to silly ones (like Fruits of the Spirit and The Burger Song) to newer songs (like Way Maker and Lighthouse). Any song that brings the love of Jesus into the hearts of our kids is welcome!

How to prepare?

- 1. Consider the audience young ears & eyes! Use accessible language that helps them understand more of who God is.
- 2. Lyrics what message do you want kids to hear?
- 3. Use visuals (optional) Kids love visuals that help connect them to what is being said! Feel free to send any pictures, lyrics or videos in advance to be added to the slideshow.
