Big Point: Courage

God's Word: Joshua becomes Israel's Leader (Joshua 1)

Memory Verse: Here is what I am commanding you to do. Be strong and brave. Do not be afraid. Do not lose hope. I am the Lord your God. I will be with you everywhere you go. (Joshua 1: 9)

Life Question: What is one promise of God that I can remind myself whenever I feel afraid?

Kids spot

Intro

Welcome children and start by asking children if they remember what they learnt on Sunday. Quick recap by reading the Memory Verse together.

Activity & Discussion

<Instruction> Today we'll look through some pictures and answer 4 questions for every picture (1) Who/ which animal is the weak one? (2) Who/ which animal is the stronger one? and (3) Who/ which animal is the courageous one? and (4) What do you learn about courage?



<Pointers for teachers>

- Weak one: small fish
- Strong one: shark (can eat the small fish anytime!)
- Courageous one: small fish
- Lesson learnt: courage = even though you're fearful because you're the weaker one, you still do not run away from your fear.



- Weak one: firemen
- Strong one/ thing: fire/ tall building
- Courageous one: firemen
- Lesson learnt: courage = fighting to protect others even if you're scared



- Weak one: mother
- Strong one/ thing: labour pain
- Courageous one: mother
- Lesson learnt: courage = love + weakness + help and support from others

Conclusion

When you have God, even if you are weak, you can be brave because God is strong and he is with you. You can protect the people you love despite the danger, with God, and with others that God placed in your life to support you.
