The Bloomingburg Masonic Lodge #449 will award a scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 to a deserving son or daughter who meets the criteria set forth in the following rules and is selected by the Lodge Awards Committee

SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. The applicant should be the son or daughter of a Mason in good standing in the lodge. However, if their brother, uncle or grandfather is a Mason in good standing in a lodge they may apply. They can also be eligible if the member is deceased, but was a member in good standing at the time of their death. They must also carry a minimum 2.0 grade point average.
2. If an applicant is selected, someone from their immediate family would not be eligible to receive the award for three years.
3. A scholarship winner may attend any two or four year accredited college, university or technical school of his/her choice and must be enrolled in a full-time program leading toward a degree.
4. The award will be made to the winner during the second quarter or semester of their first year.
5. Applicants shall submit a complete application within the specified deadline of February 28th of the current school year.
6. In judging scholarship applications, the Lodge Awards Committee shall select a list of alternates. Such alternates shall be eligible in the order of their selection for scholarships in the event that one or more of the applicants should be unable to accept a scholarship award at the time of initial selection.
