Operating in New Orleans since 2009, Make Music NOLA is a music-for-social change strings and general music education nonprofit. We aim to create access and opportunity for students who are eligible for free or reduced lunch through intensive music training. During the academic year, we conduct in-school lessons at our partner schools, and provide one-hour after-school classes on our campus in the Treme at the Bell Arts Space. Currently, we partner with four schools in the greater New Orleans area and we are looking to expand our in-school presence. Students do not have to part with their instruments after the school year as we also offer an annual, themed Summer program that takes place for three weeks during the month of June.

This Summer's program will take place June 10th through 26th and the theme will be Harmony and Health! In alignment with our mission, we will provide students with essential activities for holistic development such as self-care practices, outdoor activities, educational workshops, and nutritional education; all the while educating them of the physical and mental benefits of their music education. During the school year, MakeMusicNOLA's after school program offers 4 hours of instruction per week for our students. After school music classes correspond with the academic semester beginning the second week of September/January and lasting until the second week of December/May. Our after-school groups are separated by student abilities and take place for one hour on Monday thru Thursday, with many classes held from 4:30 to 5:30 & 5:30 to 6:30. Saturday Classes are held from 11:00am to 1:00pm with our groups taking place from 10am-11am, 11am-12pm & 12pm-1pm. This afterschool program also provides students with several opportunities to perform at different venues in the New Orleans area.

In School classes take place at different locations in the city providing general music courses or string specific classes. These classes are anywhere from 30 minutes long to 1 hour, for different levels and ages of students. Performances are held throughout the year as the school requests for their parent meetings, educational/holiday programming, and award ceremonies.

During the month of June MakeMusicNOLA has a summer music camp. This camp provides students with 5 hours of music instruction a week for three weeks as well as 5 hours of recreational time. The music camp ends with a performance at either the Bell Arts Space in the Treme or elsewhere in the city. Classes are held Monday through Friday from 4:30 to 6:30. From 12:30 to 4:30, the staff spends time planning and organizing for the incoming school year and current classes.
