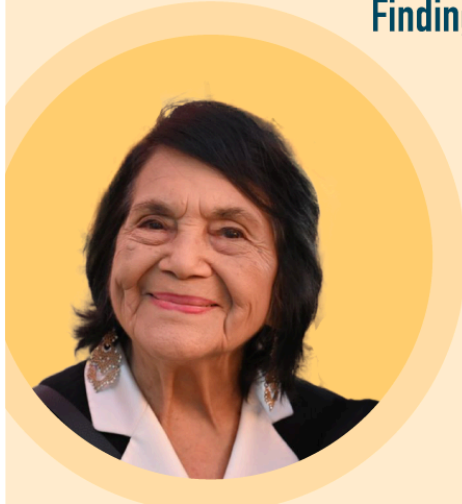


# Building Community Power in CD 22

In this difficult time, I find that it is **so important – and rewarding – to connect with others** who are working for change, and committing to support the hard work being done now. This is why I am writing to you about an important organization here in the state, **Central Valley Matters (CVM)**. Nowhere has the significance of playing the long game been demonstrated so clearly as in California's Congressional District 22. We were able to defeat Congressman David Valadao in 2018, but in the last two congressional cycles, we lost by very small margins in the face of rising Trumpism and voter apathy.

**Despite these headwinds, we succeeded** in electing a number of down ballot candidates to **protect school boards and ensure safe water access**, and to build the bench now! With the early investment of time and funds, the district is flippable!

Since CVM started in 2021, we continue to support excellent local organizations which are on the ground every day, organizing and educating. Over the years, we have vetted over 30 groups. **For 2025, we are extending our reach with six extraordinarily effective groups engaged in mobilizing communities and moving the Central Valley forward.**

Our groups report that the district is **waking up**. The Republican, David Valadao, has embraced Trump and DOGE policies, despite the severe hardships they cause for his constituents:

- 67% of the district relies on Medicaid
- CBP and ICE have ramped up terror against immigrant workers
- Devastating cuts are impacting veterans' benefits and social security which will close hospitals and health care facilities in the district
