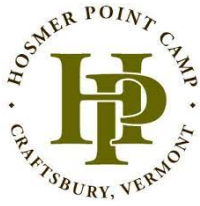


Team Mosaic Field Trip Permission Slip



Trip Date: Thursday, September 25, 8:15 A.M. - 5:45 P.M.

Description of Program: This extended day trip will focus on developing the Mosaic community. Students will engage in team-building activities such as the low ropes course, small- and large-group challenges, and goal-setting games along the shore of Great Hosmer Pond.

Cost Per Student: \$20/student

Trip Date: Wednesday, October 8, 9:00-12:30 (Batstone/Shusterman) and Thursday, October 9, 10:00-1:15 (Fary/Kebbin)

Description of Program: Mosaic students will inventory the Huntington River at Horseshoe Bend for biodiversity of macroinvertebrates, assess the chemistry of the water, and determine the physical characteristics of the stream and riparian buffer for brook trout. As a partner with Dartmouth College, students will collect dragonfly larvae to test for mercury levels as a bioindicator of stream health. Based on the results of our findings, students will evaluate whether this stream is ideal for the release of our class-raised brook trout next spring.

Trip Date: Monday, October 20, 8:05-3:30

Description of Program: In this extended day trip, students will engage in the Lumber Learning program. It supports learning about forestry and natural resource management. Students learn about forest stewardship from "seed to board" at one of the only National Park Service units practicing active forestry. This means that the park works to keep the forest healthy and prepares for impacts and stressors associated with climate change including pests, diseases, and invasive plants.
