stream and riparian buffer for brook trout. As a partner with Dartmouth College, students will collect dragonfly larvae to test for mercury levels as a bioindicator of stream health. Based on the results of our findings, students will evaluate whether this stream is ideal for the release of our class-raised brook trout next spring.
