Naming convention

All the configurations made by *FlyPrecisely* have the strict consistent format of naming for the ease of use.

Any specific aircraft or airframe is named as stated below:

AUI - Ukraine International ICAO airline code

B738 - ICAO aircraft type

UR-PSX - aircraft registration

9999 - line number (L/N) in four digits, starting from 0001

- 2. Add the configs to %Windows User%\AppData\Roaming\Microsoft Flight Simulator*
- 3. When you are ready to fly on any specific airframe and registration, please check its line number (LN) or fleet number (FN) on any online database, e. g. *Planespotters.net* (https://www.planespotters.net/)
- 4. Enter aircraft registration and open its page. Check the "Line Number" field



- 1. Add your new livery with the iFly Configuration Manager. See the "Adding Livery Info" folder in order to see the correct winglet, eyebrow and MCP options for the liveries.
- 2. After adding the livery, open aircraft.cfg of the model involved
- 3. Find your livery record and check the number in "MyConfig=" line.
- 4. Open config folder *%FlightSim Folder%\iFly\737NG\MyConfig* and find the *.ini* file of your new livery.
- 5. When you are ready to fly on any specific airframe and registration, please check its line number (LN) or fleet number (FN) on any online database, e. g. *Planespotters.net* (https://www.planespotters.net/)
