### Around the House 2 - Grade 2

Preparation prior to lesson	The Teacher prints the 4 pictures (bath, shower, toilet and mirror) and places them in corners or accessible places in the classroom, ready for the game.
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Learning Intention	I will <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Learn Auslan signs related to Around the House - bathroom and laundry.</li> </ul>
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Success Criteria	I can <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognise the bathroom and laundry signs taught.</li> <li>Correctly sign the bathroom and laundry signs.</li> <li>Use Auslan to share about their home Bathroom and Laundry.</li> </ul> <p>Class/Specialist teachers will know their class and the appropriate amount of Auslan signs that their students can learn in a lesson, in order to make the Success Criteria more specific, if required.</p>
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Time	Teacher	Resources
5 mins	Set up the video to watch. Students seated on the floor.	
5 mins	<p><b>Introduction:</b></p> <p>Introduce the topic - <b>Around the House 2</b> This time with 'Around the House', our signs relate to the bathroom and laundry. All our bathrooms and laundries will differ, but many will have the same items in them, so these are the signs that we've chosen for this lesson. Some people love the bathroom and so, many families have a 'bathroom hog', someone who is always in the bathroom! Who is your family bathroom hog? Your brother or sister, or perhaps it's you! If you're lucky you might have 2 bathrooms, so it's easier to share, or you might have 2 basins and a large mirror. Whatever your bathroom or laundry is like, we really need them in our homes to clean ourselves and our clothing. Learn and practise the signs and maybe you could describe your own bathroom(s) using Auslan.</p> <p><b>(Start of Lesson)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read and discuss the Learning Intention and Success Criteria.</li> <li>• Check for understanding, clarifying vocabulary as necessary.</li> </ul>	Provided above
10 mins	<p><b>Explicit Teaching:</b> Watch the video</p> <p>Use teacher discretion to decide if the class needs to watch any part of the video a second time.</p> <p><b>Signs taught this lesson:</b> Bathroom, mirror, toilet, sink/basin, laundry, towel, washing machine, shower, bath, tap, clothesline, clothes basket.</p>	Lesson 33 video
5 mins	<p><b>Explanation of Activity:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practise the signs taught today.</li> <li>• <b>The 4 Corner Game</b> - <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- in 4 corners of the room the teacher will place the pictures - bath, shower, toilet or mirror.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Activity sheet of pictures, below.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The students stand in the centre of the room and watch for the teacher's sign. If the teacher signs 'shower' the students must move to that picture as quickly and safely as possible. Anyone pushing or hurting others will be 'out' of the game.</li> <li>- The last person or persons to arrive at the 'shower' picture will sit out.</li> <li>- Continue until the number of students remaining is reduced. The teacher may ask a student(s) who is out to sign to the remaining students.</li> </ul> <p>We've played this game before, some time ago with different lesson content. It is usually a favourite.</p>	
15 mins	<p><b>Activity:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practise the signs taught today.</li> <li>• <b>The 4 Corner Game</b> - bath, shower, toilet, mirror.</li> </ul>	
5 mins	<p><b>Reflection with Students:</b> (Select from the following options)</p> <p>Use Auslan to share about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Our homes are all different. Do you have a toilet in your bathroom?</li> <li>• Also some homes have more than one toilet and also bathroom. Explain what you have at home, using Auslan signs and numbers. (sign: bathroom 2)</li> <li>• Could you sign about your bathroom - the colour of the walls (sign:bathroom colour green), how many mirrors? Do you have both a shower and a bath or just a shower?</li> <li>• Is your laundry in your bathroom or is it separate?</li> <li>• Which sign from today did you like the best?</li> </ul>
