Updates from MDN

Mouvement Démocratie Nouvelle recently presented a <u>brief to the Directeur général des</u> <u>élections du Québec</u>, arguing that electoral reform should be included in its <u>review of the</u> province's election laws.

MDN Vice President Guillaume Daigneault recently wrote two op-eds, one in <u>Le Devoir</u>, and another in <u>La Presse</u>, pointing out the senselessness in amending the provincial ridings when the true problem is the electoral system.
