Abstract:

Fix gradle so that it will insert Google analytics code into the JavaDoc that is hosted on the BoofCV website. This is a known issue and it's already in Gradle's bug tracker [GRADLE-3099](#). Analytics is used to track web visitors and see what capabilities of BoofCV they are interested in. Currently an Ant script is being maintained for this one feature only.

Completion Criteria:

- Modify the Gradle source code so that Google Analytics used by BoofCV's maintainers can be correctly injected into JavaDoc
- The patch needs to be accepted by the Gradle maintainers and included in the next released version

How To Test:

- 'git checkout SNAPSHOT'
- 'gradle WebJavaDoc'
- If you see a lot of error message like the below then it is still broken

```
javadoc: error - Illegal package name: ", "
```

- Once there are no error messages check the generated HTML to see if the analytics was correctly inserted
