Clothing

Please can you ensure that your child has named and appropriate clothing for the changing weather conditions, coats must be provided as we continue to go outside in all weathers. On hot days, you will need to ensure your child has had sun cream on before each session, those children who attend all day will have sun cream reapplied for the afternoon session (please provide a named sun cream and place it in the sun cream box). Named hats also need to be provided (and placed in the sunhat box). LACES are very hard for children to become independent. Please try to dress your child in appropriate footwear and clothing to support their independence. Please also be mindful that children may get messy and dirty as they explore the curriculum 3h play in the setting.

Session times

At Jack in the Box your child's safety and wellbeing is our priority. To ensure this we need to have clear and smooth transition times. It is very important that you are dropping off and collecting your child promptly at the start/end of their session as these times are a key transitional period for all parents and children and we may need to share information with you before seeing the children in/out of their session. If you wish to speak to a member of staff, please can you ensure you wait until all the children are in or out of their current session. If you know you are going to be late for whatever reason, please call to let us know. Thank you for helping with this.

Breakfast club: 8:15am – 9am (must arrive before 8:30am)

Morning session: 9am – 12pm Lunch club: 12pm – 1pm

Afternoon session: 1pm - 3pm Tea Club Session: 3pm-4pm

Phonics

Phonics will continue to be a focus throughout our daily play and within our morning focus time, if you need any support with phonetic sounds please do not hesitate to ask. School leavers will be coming home with a home learning pack

Toilet Training & dummies

We want to support you and your child in every way possible. If your child is 3 & upwards, then this is a great time to begin toilet training if you haven't already. This is a large part of your child's personal and physical development and important for getting them ready for their transition to school. Please talk to a member of staff if you need any support. The use of dummies may delay speech and language, we can support you and your child with a successful dummy fairy plan that is exciting and fun and may help your child with this next transition stage.
