RESEARCH Essays, Projects and Artist Statements

Knowing what you are writing about and to whom you are writing aids in the structure and address of how you communicate.

- 1. **Introduction (10%)**: Includes an attention-grabbing lead sentence; provides background information, provides a clear and focused thesis statement.
- 2. **Body (40%)**: Contains three paragraphs that follow the pattern of organization established in the thesis statement.
- 3. **Conclusion (10%)**: Revisits the thesis statement, and connects back to an example in the introduction.
- 4. **Transitions (5%)**: The essay reads smoothly from start to finish, with a logical flow of progression from one point to the next.
- 5. **Grammar (10%)**: Sentence structure
- 6. Usage (10%): Subject/verb agreement
- 7. **Mechanics (10%)**: Spelling and punctuation
- 8. **Cite Sources (5%):** If your writing has **ANY** research or referenced-based information sources **MUST** be cited.
