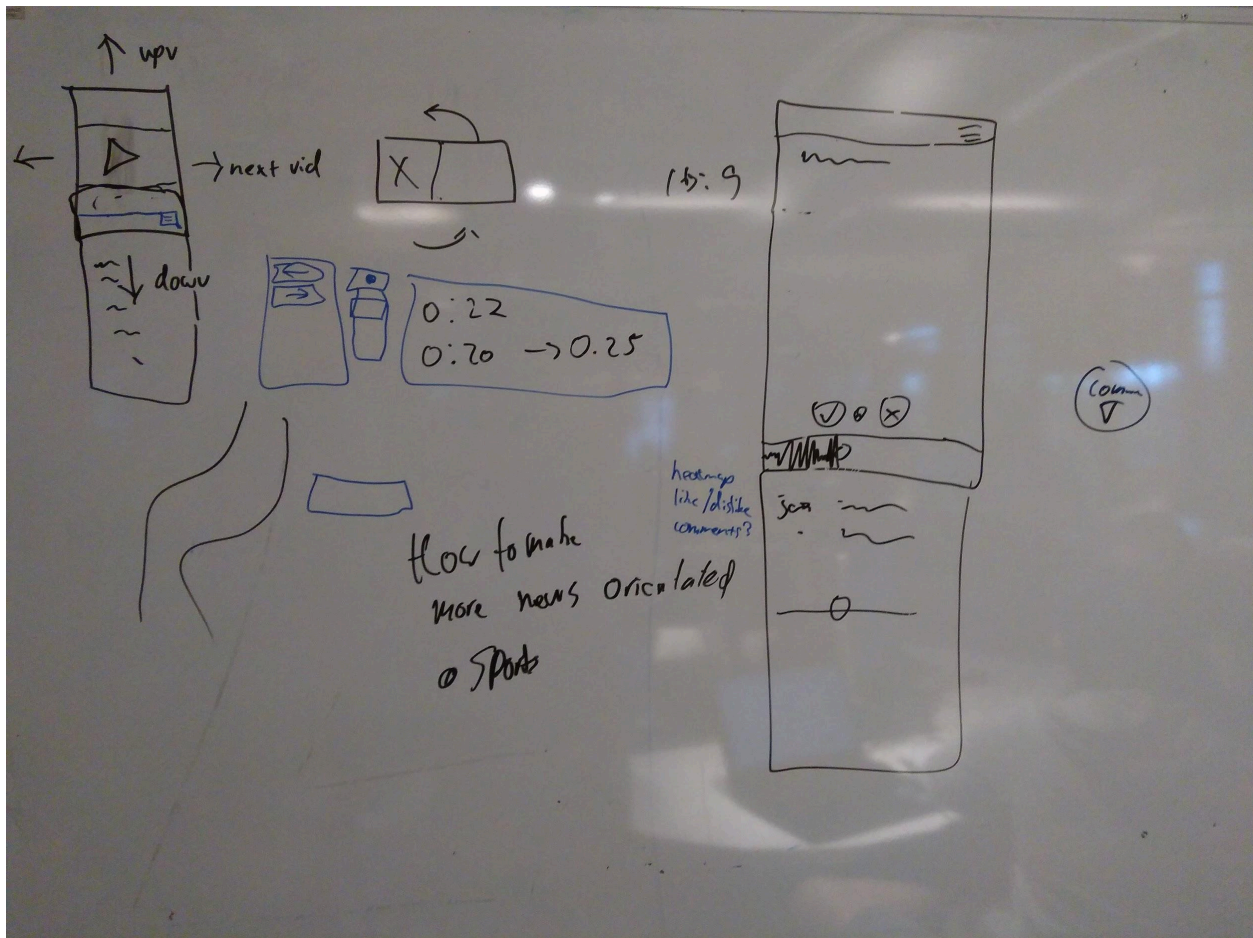

 - Up/down voting comments

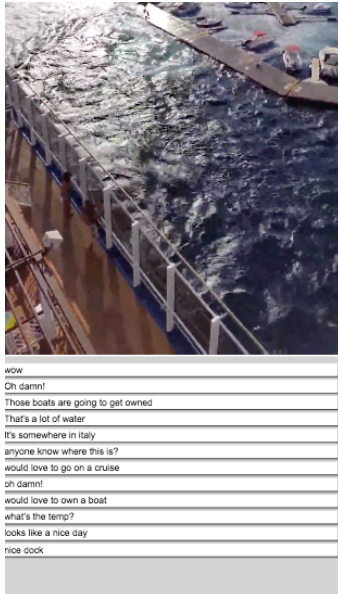
- Top comments flying across ticker-style (on top of screen)

- Basic Chrome Extension created

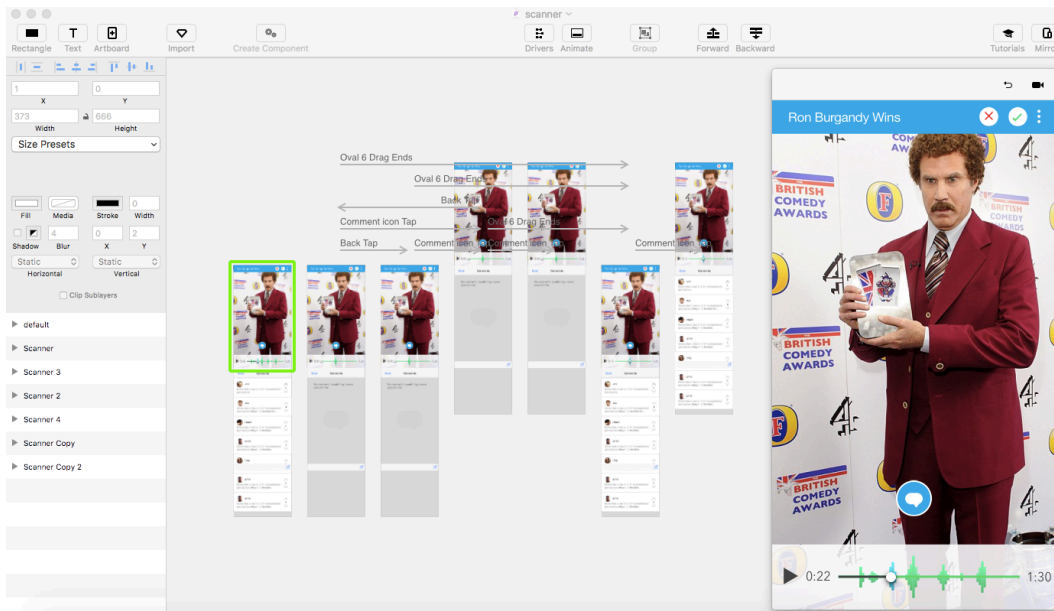
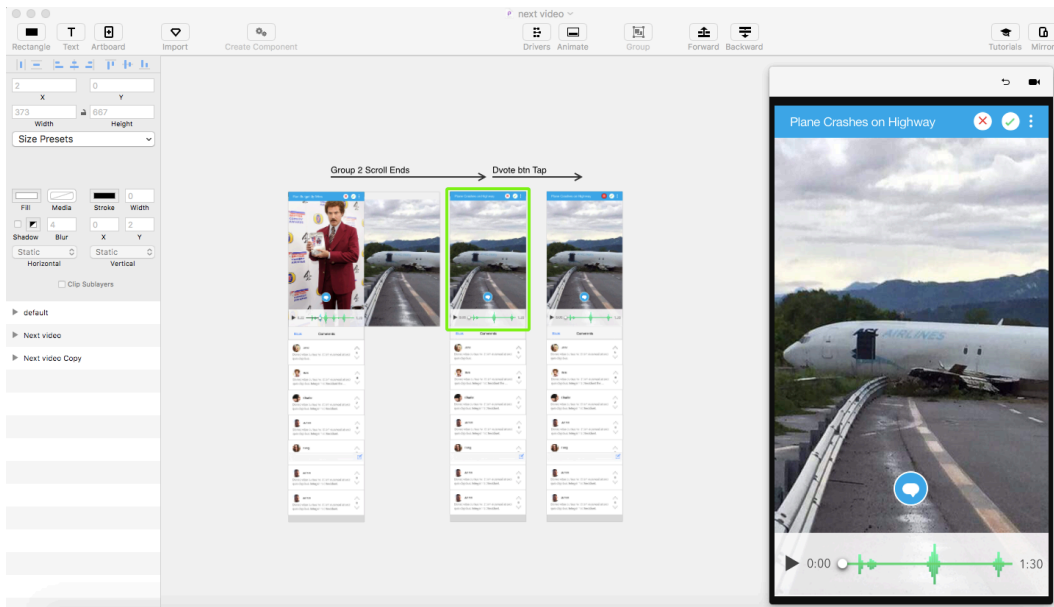

Fang:

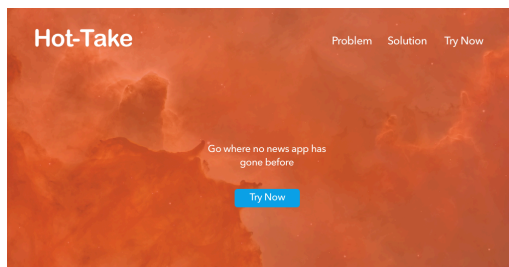

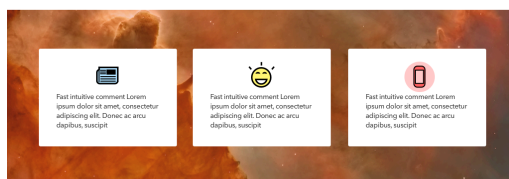

Comment on the moment that matters. When you find an interesting part of the video, swipe down to join the conversation.

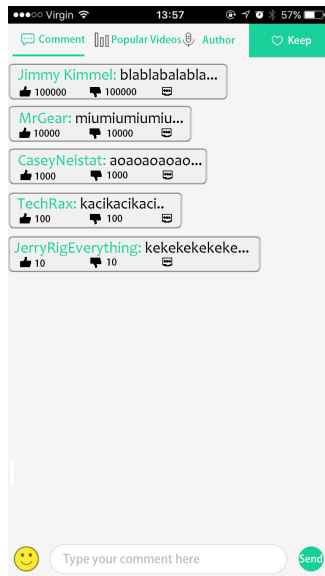
Heatmap

Tasks:

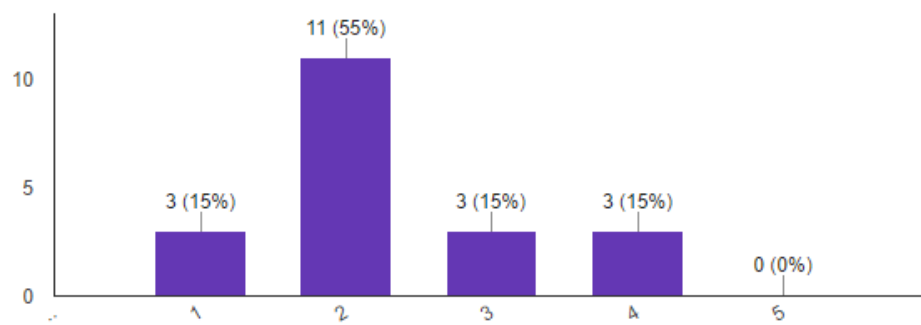
1. Find out how to change the video

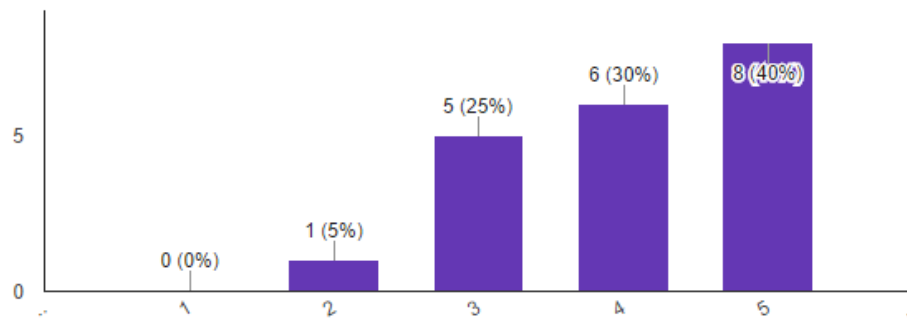

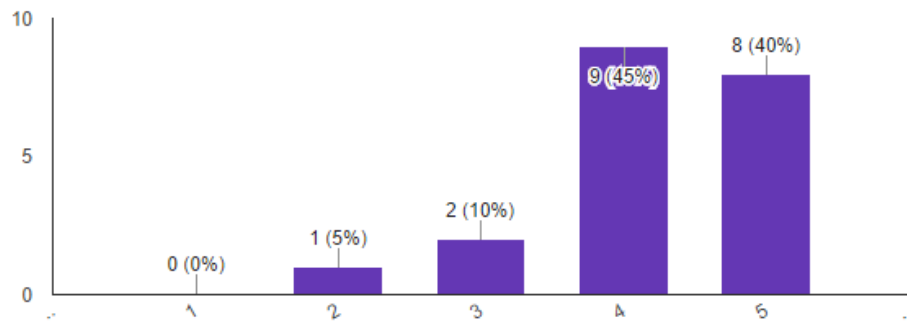
To what extent do you think the app is easy to use? (20 条回复)



To what extent do you think this app is useful to users? (20 条回复)

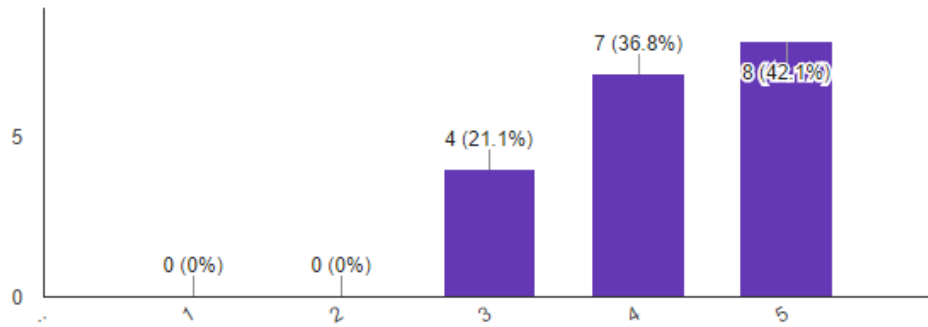


To what extent do you think this app is efficient for you to finish the task? (20 条回复)

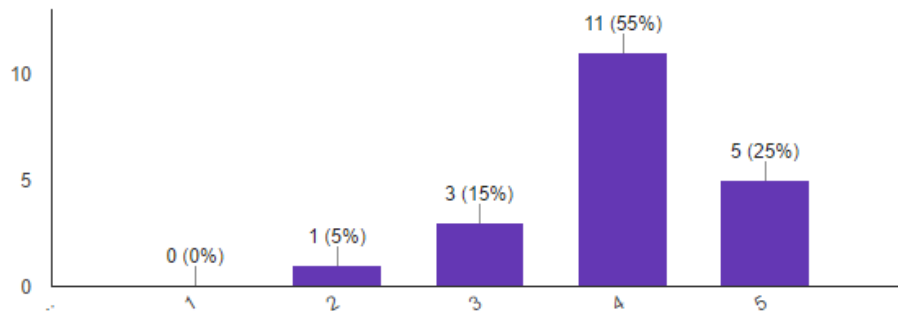


To what extent do you think you can finish all the tasks without further instructions or others' help?

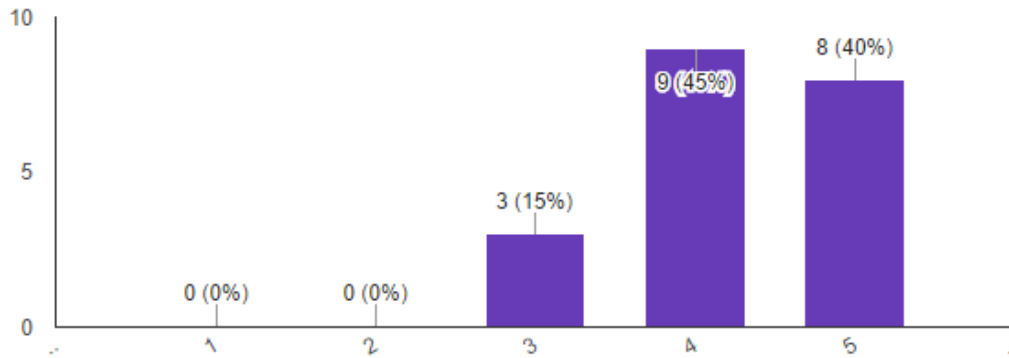

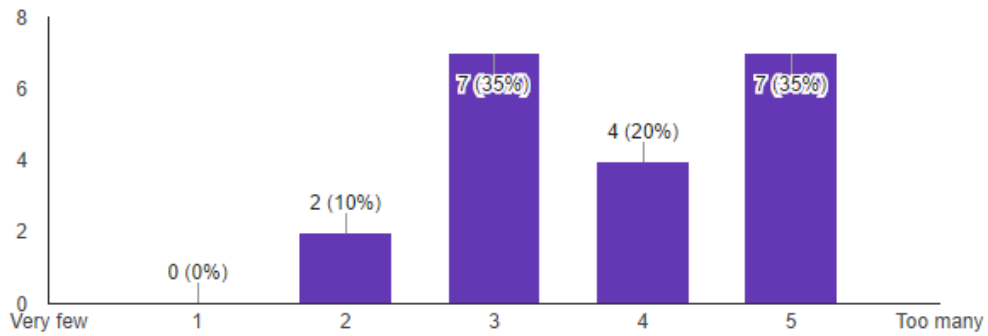
To what extent are you satisfied with the app? (20 条回复)
