

2. Practice: Make a small practice pillow.

Sew 2 small pieces of fabric together to make a small pillow. See videos below.

Steps: Sew inside-out, ¾ of the way around, using backstitch, stop, remove pins, turn right-side-out, stuff with fabric scraps, sew closed with ladder or invisible stitch


3. Plan: Sketch a plan for your own toy. Include sketches of your finished design and your paper templates (sewing pattern).




paper pattern (template) example:


4. Make:

- -A template or pattern by drawing a design on paper and cut out. Make template 1/2" bigger all the way around, for the seam
- -Pin your template to two pieces of fabric (must be face to face) and cut them out
- -Pin the 2 pieces of fabric together face to face (inside out).
- -Doing backstitch, sew around the edge, stopping when you have 2" still open.






- Unpin and turn right side out.
- -Stuff.
- -Sew closed using ladder stitch.



5. Reflect. Reflection will be posted as a separate assignment.
