

Lein-Svencner: Floating Collage Composition

- 2-Wood Panels select the size you desire-12 x 16

- 2 sheet 140lb Watercolor paper, (cold or hot press) 14 x 18
- **Gloss** medium-Golden Brand, or Liquix-Gloss/Varnish 16 oz.
- A good selection colors, acrylic paints, artist grade or craft, plus white, black and brown
- Brushes, a variety sizes, small round for detail to larger flat edge.
- Large Water container
- Spray bottle-for water
- Sketchbook, 8 x 10 or smaller (for collage sketching and note taking)
- 2 or 3 glue sticks
- National Geographic magazine (2) and another of your choice to use for images and added words, (1)
- Drawing mediums, like Stabilo's, watercolor pencils, pastel pencil, Wax crayons- Caron d'ache neocolor water-soluble (see what you have around, Caron d'ache, the best to use)
- Found papers, maps, book pages, gift papers, found images extra, a medium assortment.
- Printed images from **laser copy machine only**, in color of animals, people or things option.
- A tub of baby wipes
- Roll of paper towels
- Roll of wax paper, (used to stack and store coated collage papers, they will stick together if not between wax paper.)
- Stamping, stencils, and printing objects-used to alter the surface of your collage papers
- Plastic tablecloth, 1-dollar store kind
- Newspapers (1-days' worth) used for workstation of coating papers, very important.
- Cosmetic sponges-small triangle wedges. Handful will work just fine.
- Sponge roller- craft store or a painter's store is where they can be found.
- Stack of coated paper plates to use for your paint palette
- Drawing paper, 1 pad, not larger than 14 x 11
- Blue painters' tape
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Utility knife

***Use of tack irons and safety release paper will be provided, small wood blocks will be included in Workshop fee along with handouts and other misc. materials to make this the best time ever.
