I am delighted to tell you that school, working in partnership with Mr Hanson's coaching company Primary Influence UK, has been successful in its bid for Healthy Holidays funding to run a holiday camp during the Easter and summer holidays. The camps will be active and fun sessions for pupils consisting of sports activities, arts and crafts, baking, gardening and trips. The camps will be led by Mr Hanson (our school sports coach) and staffed by qualified coaches and school staff.

The camps will run:

Monday 7th April – Friday 11th April (first week of the Easter holidays)

Monday 21st July – Friday 25th July (week 1 of the summer holidays)

Monday 28th July – Friday 1st August (week 2 of the summer holidays)

Monday 4th August – Friday 8th August (week 3 of the summer holidays)

The camps will run daily from **8:30am-2:45pm.**

The camps will be **FREE OF CHARGE** to pupils in receipt of free school meals.

The Healthy Holidays scheme which will fund the camps “**provides free engaging and enriching activities with a hot and healthy meal for children and young people during the holidays.**” The scheme is funded by the Department for Education's Holiday Activities and Food Programme.
