Supplies & Prep Page

Supplies:

- Wire, 1.5mm, 18 gauge or similar. 2 yards.
Note: Can be found at craft stores, hardware stores or online.
- Wool roving in fox colors. Half an ounce of orange (or your chosen main color) and small amounts (a few grams) of white, brown or black if you want to vary the color of the paws, tail, ears and chest. Can be bought online at Outback Fibers, or Amazon or at your local fiber arts store.
- Wool yarn, bulky, color not super important, but similar to the main roving color is helpful. This is to wrap around the wire as a base, so you don't need tons.
- Core wool for building up the shape before you add color, or if you have enough fox colored roving, you can use it for both inner and outer layers. I suggest having an ounce handy, though it should take less. "Core wool" is generally coarser and less expensive than colored / dyed wool for building a foundation.
