

## Epic Challenge Rundown

- All player must pay at the front desk and obtain their receipt to sign in
- Both partners will be added to the rotation after checking in and making the payment
- The top 3 pairs of players with the most total winning points **signed in before 7 pm** will be seeded and will start their night at the final stage. In the situation when there is a tie for points. The team that completed the sign-in first will be seeded until all 3 seeds slots are filled

Games start at 7 pm, matches will be announced at the table, the # of courts will depend on the number of entries for the evening

- 3 min Warm-ups (birds not provided)
- Game birds will be provided when matches begin.
- All matches will be 1 set to 21 points, **no tie breaker**

Female players and Junior players will have a handicap point to balance the game

(4 points for mixed, 8 points for ladies doubles pair, 3 points for each junior player under 14)

Ex. Mens' doubles team vs Ladies double team      game will start at 0 – 8  
Ladies double vs mixed doubles with 1 junior      (8 – 7) games will start at 1-0

\*Teams can give up their advantage points

## Final stage (kings court)

The winning team will stay on and keep playing on kings court, there will be a small break in between games while the new challenger warms up, but the new match must start within 5 minutes after the previous.

## Pricing:

General: \$17/person

Students: \$12/person

General Buy 1 get 1 50%: \$25.50/pair

Student Buy 1 get 1 50%: \$18/pair (*BOTH MUST BE CURRENT EPIC STUDENTS*)

## Promotional Policies:

Weekly Promotions & Eligibility: Discounts are strictly applied based on the specific theme of the week. To receive the "Second Player Discount," the pair must meet the category requirements (e.g., a Mixed pair for Mixed Doubles Night).

Mandatory Check-In: Both partners must check in together at the front desk by 7:00 PM sharp.

Digital Verification: We will use the digital attendance system to verify your name and category at check-in.

Partner Substitutions: You may substitute a partner before the match starts, provided the category remains the same (e.g., replacing one female partner with another on Women's Night).

Voiding the Discount: If a partner swap changes your team's category (e.g., switching from Mixed Doubles to Men's Doubles on Mixed Night), the promotion is void. The standard full-price entry fee will be required for both players at the door, and entry will be subject to bracket availability.

Changing Partners? If you need to substitute your partner after registration, you must complete the Registration form again (*at least 2 hours before the event*).

**Important: If the new partner changes the team category (e.g., Mixed to Men's), the discount is void, and the non-promotional price must be paid at 7:00 PM check-in.**

**Details:**

- There will be 2 pools if there are more than 40 players.  
*\*Points will always be recorded for Pool A (Advanced players/1 pool). In the event that Pool B (Intermediate) is opened, points will not be recorded for Pool B.*
- Damaged birds must be brought to the table to exchange for another shuttle
- Used shuttles **MUST** be brought back to the table when reporting scores.
- Winners will advance to the next stage and add stage # on paper, losers will be crossed off and write down their names again following the previous team for their next match
- Teams will wait for their next match to be announced, and failure to show on their courts 5 min after the announcement is an automatic default
- Raffles will be held weekly, players may come pick up their prizes after the challenge
