Guidelines and tidbits to make script formatting easy peasy!

Script Submission Status: **OPEN**

Current Characters: All characters (fandom and original) that have been posted before are open for submissions! No Character scripts are welcome as well!

Script Information - Please include at the top of the script with everything filled in!

Title: *Insert Script Name*

Character: *Name or "No Character"*

Listener Gender: *M? F? Ambiguous?*

SFW or NSFW?

Word Count: *Suggested count 750+ words of Character dialog*

Author Credit: *Name or Pen Name you wish to go by*

Script Example

Listen, I know it might be a little scary, taking a leap and sharing a piece of your writing like this. But trust me, no matter what, it'll be a great experience! Practice and honing your craft is never a wasted effort, and taking chances to get your voice, your writing out there? That's absolutely worth it!

[Expressing uncertainty]

It's going to be okay, I promise. You'll never know until you try, right? C'monnnnn, I know you're excited to give it a go. And even if the first piece doesn't work out, it's great practice, and you'll only get better and better. I know you're excited to try, you can't hide it from me!

[Reluctant laughter]

There's that smile! Now, knock 'em dead!

Submission Instructions

- Email your script as an **attachment** to: yuurivoicescripts@gmail.com
 - Please make the subject of your email: **[Character Name] Script Title [SFW/NSFW]**
 - If sharing through google drive: **share with full edit permissions to** yuurivoicescripts@gmail.com
 - Keep an eye on your email! All submissions will receive a confirmation that the script has been received and all scripts will receive notice of either approval or otherwise.
 - If your script is approved, fill out the writer permission form that will be emailed to you!
 - **ALL AUTHORS MUST BE 18+ TO SUBMIT SCRIPTS**
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Notes and other details!

- You are welcome to add additional formatting, color coding, etc. in your script but the above snippet is the bare minimum, and I enjoy the simplicity because it makes for an easy read when recording.
- Breaks where the listener interjects or an action happens lets me know that there needs to be a pause. This works better for me when recording vs. a traditional script, and is less hassle.
- Direction and tone notes can be kept to a minimum. In complex or special cases, feel free to explain, but in general I should be able to feel the mood and tone from dialog itself. A ton of notes feels restricting and busy on the page for recording purposes.
- On the topic of NSFW scenes, you don't need to write every breath, moan, and utterance, as a lot of that is improvised on the spot. Feel free to include notes about the specific act, some specific lines used, etc. but you'll know when you hit a part that could simply be noted "they do the thing, he says a naughty bit, finish" and if there are specifics for a shift that need to be scripted, write it, but otherwise you don't have to be super detailed and thorough. I gotchu.
- A final note: don't get hung up on characterization TOO much. If in the recording process something feels like it doesn't roll right, I can adlib and it'll turn out just fine. I know that in the writing process we can be our own toughest critics, but trust me when I say, you don't have to sweat over every word, every line. If you're reading this far, I'm guessing you've got faith in me to do your ideas and stories justice, and I want you to know I have faith in you too.

FAQ

Are script submissions still open?

Yes! Script submissions are open indefinitely! We will let you know if that changes!

How will I know if my script is accepted?

All correspondence after a script is submitted will be handled through the script email. Writers will be informed when scripts are received and after review the writer will be informed if the script has been accepted into the index to be recorded.

What do I need to do after my script is accepted?

Writers will receive a writers permission form in their email upon script acceptance. This will also include filling out information for credit! Once this is filled out and the writer has consented to YuuriVoice's use of the script, then you just have to wait!

Do writers receive the audio when it's recorded?

No, the writers will hear the audios when they go public.

Do I have to be 18 to write an NSFW script?

Yes. Don't even try if you're not. On that note, all characters MUST be 18+ within canon to be considered for recording.

Can I write BDSM/PTSD/Anxiety/Etc scripts?

Yes, the rule of thumb to follow is to keep scripts that dive into intense topics (kink, mental health, or otherwise) at a 7/10 intensity. Remember that these scripts are for a wide audience so we want to keep them accessible to everyone who wants to listen! If you are concerned about a very specific topic feel free to ask!

What are some things that might get my script sent back?

Unnecessary location changes in the audio: these can be difficult to portray in audios and oftentimes are unnecessary, consider having the characters just talk about the reasons why they are where they are instead of having it acted out.

Improper formatting: scripts sent in the body of emails or as pdfs are hard for us to organize so we may send back requesting that they are sent properly.

Not meeting word count: The recommended word count is 750 words of character dialog. In audio form about 100 words is 1 minute of audio time, anything shorter than 750 words would be too short of an audio for production!
