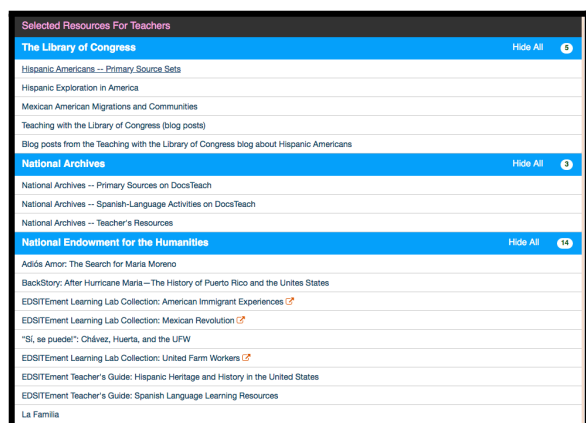


[PBS Learning Media: Latino-Americans](#) For grade 4 through high school.

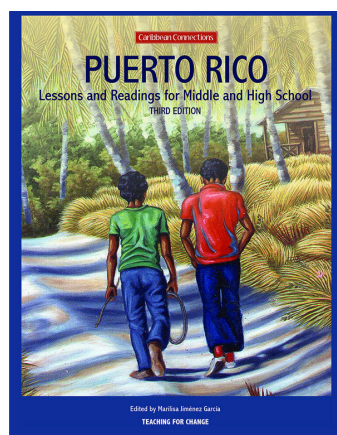
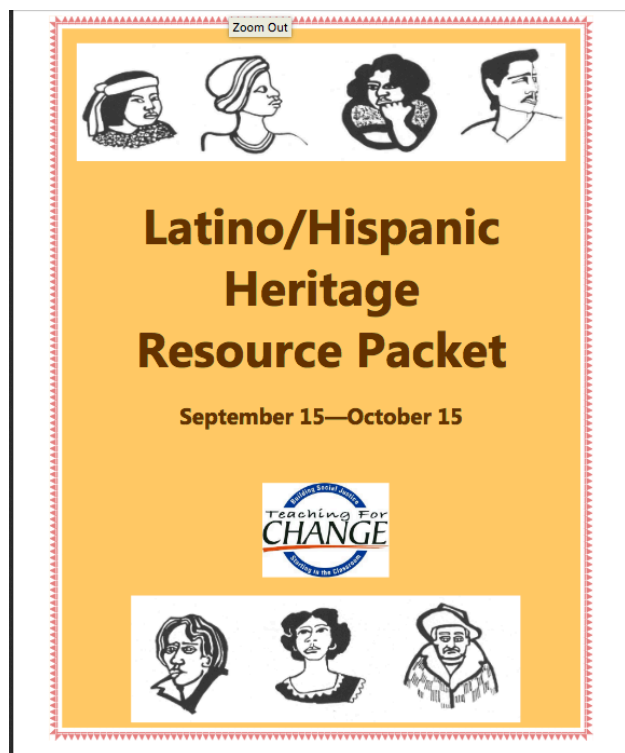
