The Situation

Both Ridgeside and Longrock have been taken. The Republic have fallen into full retreat back to their outposts at Selara and Largona. The Republic have sent ships through the canyons in their escape attempt, leaving the ground behind Ridgeside damaged by their destroyed trenches and ITEC have started a new mining site alongside the outpost, Ridgeside has several bridges leading northward, northeast and a passageway with several smaller bridges leading northwest. The Republic maintains a sizable amount of ships and artillery that far outranges us, as for now, the northeast bridge is the only one we can push over.

The Defensive Plan

Phase One.

Point A: The Shield Generator from Mosanek has been moved up to Ridgeside. It is defended by Military Police directly overseen by Neophyte Roi.

Point B: We have planted mines in the central pathway, past the north bridge, northwest passageway and northeast bridge for them to encounter upon approach to either us or the ITEC facility to give forewarning in their passageway.

Point C: We have set up sandbags and barricades on the ridges of ridgeside, giving multiple layers of firing positions overlooking the path to ITEC and the bridges, giving us several chokepoints in which to fire down upon them. These men include AT Troopers, standard Infantry and Marksmen primarily. We are using gun emplacements and bunkers to provide additional repeating fire, some of the EMPed emplacements left behind by the Republic have been fixed up to add to our arsenal the bridges are extremely easy to defend from our position.

Point D: We have placed several Anti-Air and Artillery Emplacements on Ridgeside at both the Airbase and Ridgeside Actual.

Point E: We have deployed Dorne and Probe Droids as well as the mines, in the Northeast pathway between Largona and us, this is primarily to give us forewarning about any advances made towards the northeast or towards ITEC.

Point F: We have planted charges on rocks on the path to ITEC. This is a cost effective way to collapse stone on the pathway and cut off that path for the Republic, trapping any vanguard into a killzone.

Point G: We've set up several devastators and crawler tanks to defend both positions, behind the sandbags, able to fire over the ridge.

Point G1: To move them in position a small prefab ramp has been built, to make travel

easier.

Point H: We have deployed probes into the canyon, to scout out the positions for Phase Two.

Point I: A small trench has been set up far back as a defensive position. It creates a good killzone.

Phase Two.

Canyon Defence

Point I: Once the canyon has been scouted out, we are looking to set up hidden AT Soliders within the canyon itself to defend from vics coming through.

Point J: A fighter duo, hide within the canyon, waiting to take a strafing run at enemy positions

Point K: Motorpools are being set up at Rennar, as well as several logistics stations to allow the quick transfer of people and resources up through Rennar, as well, as some of trenches are being redug to provide a fallback point from Ridgeside, making any retreat swift as possible, able to provide reinforcements and transit to those within Ridgeside.

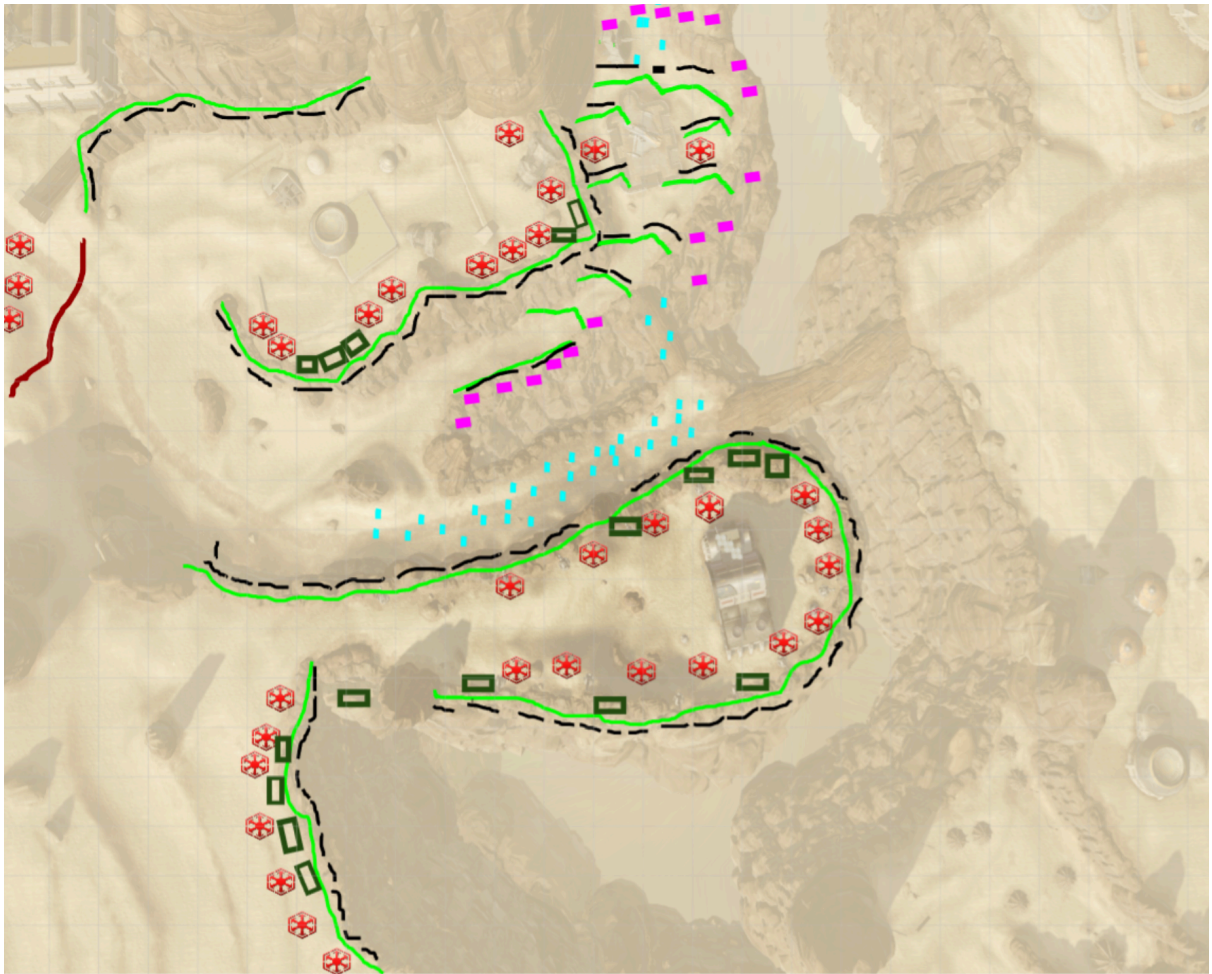
Point L: The airfield will be occupied by our fighters now we've secured the area around it.

Point M: A trenchline has been dug in at the path to ITEC's mining point, to aid in repulsing it, as well as an array of sensors. They have been given radiation equipment on Sith Vipions orders, if necessary they are to retreat back to ITEC. Behind them are positioned Crawlers to cover a withdrawal through the territory, charges have been set, to allow us to collapse the path temporarily to halt the Republic advance.

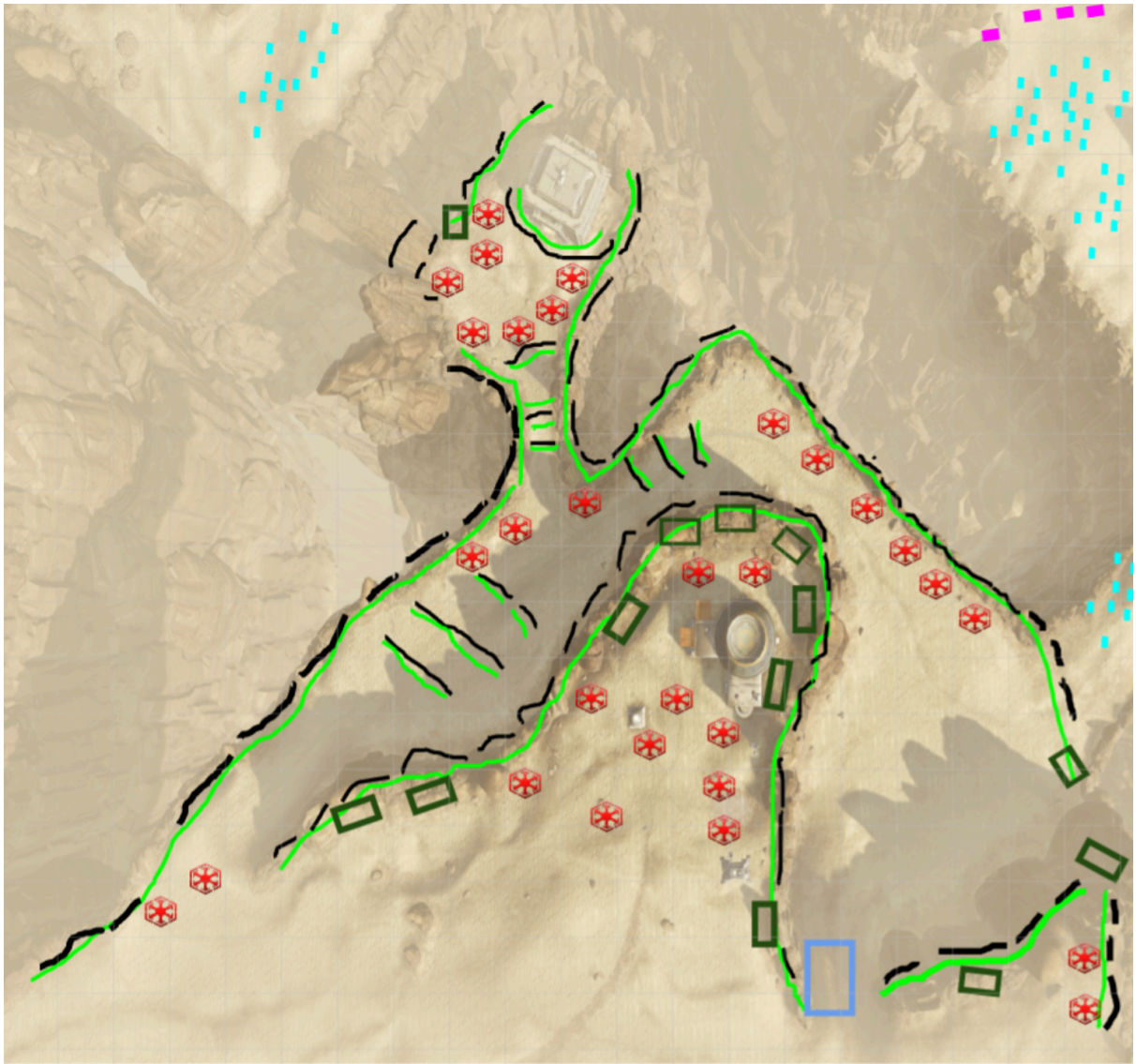
Point N: Most Tanks have been replaced with Walkers along the edge of the ridges. The tanks are now being pulled further back to sit behind trench lines, Crawlers have been withdrawn back from the front and will be used in addition to the artillery droids to bombard the enemy with heavy mortars.

Point O: Turrets are among the reinforcing group.

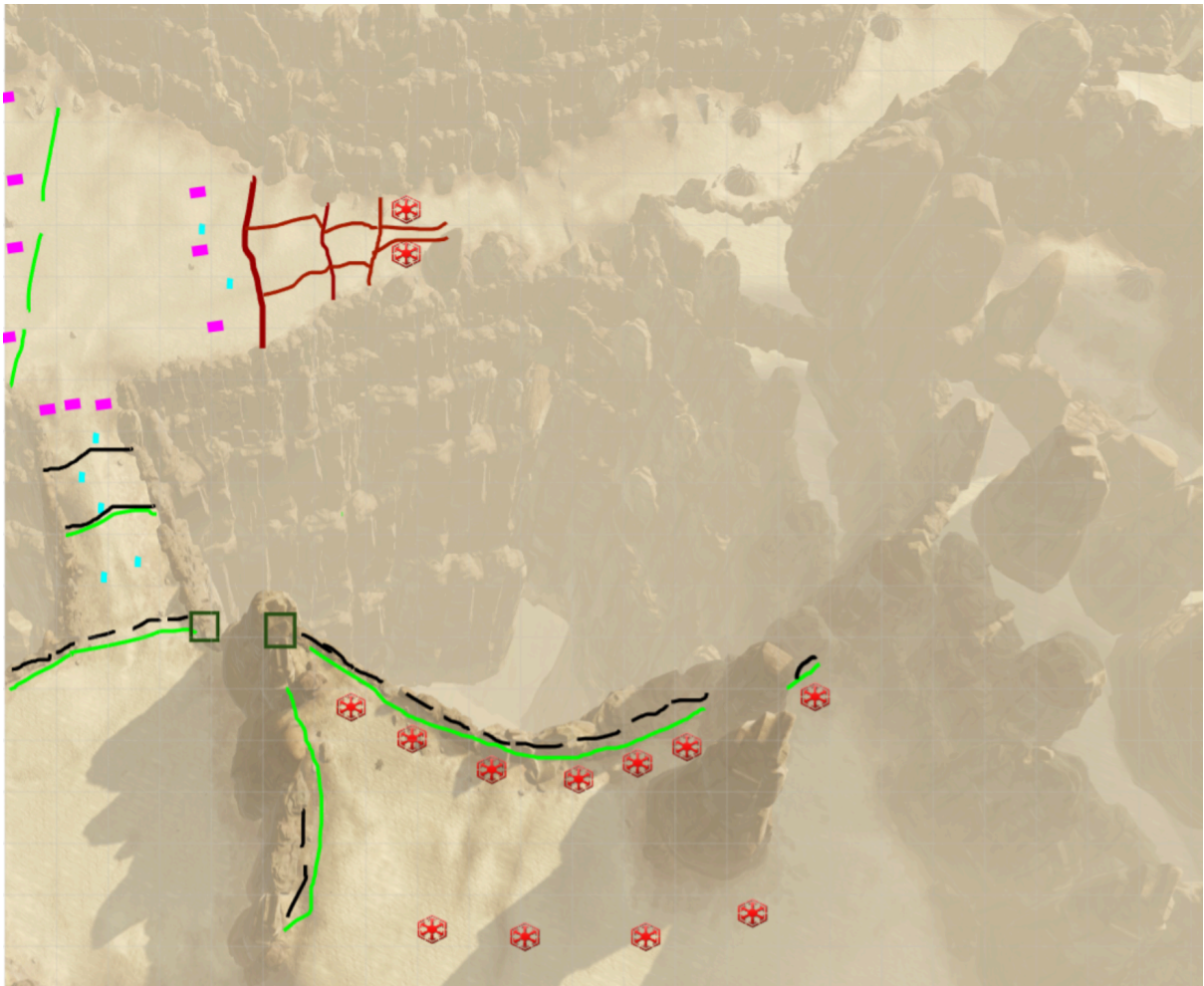
