For the next few weeks we will be using the Google Classroom to continue your learning. During this time you are still "in school," and you will have various assignments to complete along with comp checks (quizzes) so I can measure your understanding of our standards.

Here's how it will work for us:

- You must log on at some point at *least* once a week to complete your assignments.
- How you complete your assignments is completely up to you. For example, you can work on your assignments over multiple days or you can finish it all in one day if you wish. I want to give you flexibility so that you are able to complete your work for other classes as well!
- To find your assignments, click on the Classwork tab at the top of the screen.
- Your assignments will be placed in groups for each week called a topic. Remember, you have the entire week to complete everything in each week's topic.
- After that week has passed each assignment will be graded for completion.

If at any point you have any questions, comments, or concerns, please contact Ms. Riley in any of the following ways:
