

St. Louis City - Name Change Adult

Important Information

Beginning in 2021, the Circuit Court of St. Louis City changed its process for adults who are filing to change their name *pro se* (without an attorney).

Adults in St. Louis City no longer need to have a court hearing to change their name.

In place of the hearing, file these two additional documents:

- a) “Affidavit for Judgment for Name Change (St. Louis City)” form when you file the rest of the forms.
- b) a copy of your current birth certificate (does not have to be a certified copy; you can even email them a scan or legible photo)

The St. Louis City court employee who usually handles *pro se* name change cases is a paralegal named Tracy Wells. She has a history of supporting trans folks and can be helpful if you have extra questions. twells@courts.mo.gov (314) 641-8448
