Planting trees in student housing in order to reduce the use of grass cultivation, reduce the amount of water used, and also raise the percentage of vegetables inside the housing. Some of the flowering shrubs that we have planted are of different colors and do not require large amounts of water. They give the green color to the leaves and the different color to the flowers. They are produced by the university nurseries.

Also, trees were planted in residential neighborhoods with the aim of increasing the agricultural area and reducing desertification, as well as consuming a small amount of water and preserving the environment in the presence of a healthy environment for all residents of the university and used as shades and pest control. Examples of some of the used plants inside the campus:
