Parents, teachers, and librarians can use it to spice up their read alouds or revisit old favorites by adding a new soundscape. Students can practice their reading fluency as the app responds to their voice. This app is SO FUN! You will need a paper copy of most books, although some come with free eBooks through apple books.



Give your photos a voice with ChatterPix! Chatterpix can make anything talk — pets, friends, doodles, and more! Simply take any photo, draw a line to make a mouth, and record your voice. Use Chatterpix to allow pictures of whatever content you are studying (biographies, dinosaurs, etc.) to tell the class about themselves. The videos are 30 seconds maximum.
