By clarifying which data matter most, aligning assessment systems with instructional priorities, and embedding data use into collaborative practices, we're aiming to reduce noise and strengthen our MTSS. Participants will hear how these shifts have improved decision-making, supported responsive interventions, and built shared ownership.
