Additional Details

Coverage details mean you will have \$0 out-of-pocket expense for the first incident. With additional incidents, you will be expected to pay \$25 for second incidents and \$50 for third or

more incidents. If the device was intentionally or excessively damaged, the cost for repair/replacement will be up to \$228. Lost or stolen Chromebooks will also be up to \$228.
