- Duchess: Perla
- Cook: Bogdan
- Narrator: "Alice finds a house. It's noisy! Inside, the Duchess is holding a crying baby and the cook is preparing a meal."
- Alice: "Why does your cat grin like that?"
- Duchess: "It's a Cheshire Cat. That's why. I have to go with the Queen now. Here. Take the baby."
- Narrator: "The Duchess leaves, and Alice walks outside with the baby. But the baby turns into a pig!"
- Alice: "Ahhhhh! You're a pig now! Let me put you down." (PIG NOISES) the pig goes away
- Narrator: "Alice lets the pig go, and then she sees the Cheshire Cat in a tree."
