IV. **Commissioner reports:**

Girls LAX (Kelly Higgins, Mary Beth Lockard)-

- Registration in process for 2026 season. Currently 36 players registered. Registration closes on January 16th. Rosters are due to LVGLL by February 4th.
- Based on current registration, looks like there will be one team per age group
- Store from Army Navy open until January 16th
- Coaching needs-May need 2 head coaches for 5/6 group, 1-2 for 3/4 age group and 1 for K-2
- New uniforms will be ordered as necessary. Based on registration, may need some goalie equipment, pinnies, and first aid supplies.
- Complete inventory of equipment was performed the week of Thanksgiving
- Tuskes Fields (lower and middle) will be used for practice and games for mid March. Will utilize upper deck/ possible other facility for the first few weeks due to weather. This is up in the air depending on the schedule from the league which is yet to be finalized. The township has been contacted in regard to renting the fields and obtaining fobs for the equipment shed.
- Parent Volunteerism- Most likely will have fields professionally lined to start the season and then maintain lining manually.
- Fundraising- lottery tickets and Hershey tickets
- Off Season Training- There was a free clinic held by the LVGLL on Dec 29th and there is interest to have a weekly get together by some of the LAX community. Discussed room in gyms possibly but basketball is monopolizing the space due to the amount of teams from K-12.

Football (Melissa Dewey, Tony Genao, Brandon Smith)-

- 2026 Cheer/Football registration will open 4/4/26 at 8:00 AM. Moving to the first Saturday in April registration date for the foreseeable future
- Still have not received 100% of the uniforms. Will be cashing checks this week. The list of players added to the "Not in Good Standing List" will be given to Tony for league communication
- New pants are going to be ordered
- Helmets are getting refurbished this year
- Looking to replace some jerseys and plan for all new jerseys for the 2028 season
- League- officially in the Colonial Youth Football League. First meeting is 1/13/26 at 7:30 PM. New league email is written and will be sent this weekend
- Snack Stand- donated the remainder of our snack stand food to wrestling for their season. Everything will be moved back to Lower Nazareth when complete.
