 - This is a draft, talking about the school summary report, parent survey will be shared and emailed to members. Need to get from F to C, need to grow in domain 1 and 2. The focus will be 4th and 5th graders. Ratings are determined by growth, we need 63 kids to grow in reading and math in order to make the C. Bilingual students need to maintain gains in TELPAS. Summit K12 is the curriculum being used to support bilingual students. Strategies for Govalle is a closure reassignment. TNTP is part of this year's plan, for this last rating. Govalle is a lighthouse school and other schools make visits during TNTP walks. Vincent asked about the curriculum and how it is delivered by teachers. Doug asked what the difference is between TNTP and the prior year as far as coaching/walkthroughs. PLCs and walkthroughs are more focused given the TNTP model.
