Fun Ways To Prepare for Kindergarten:

- 1) Read to your child for 10-15 minutes a day! This helps them develop language and listening skills and prepares them to understand text.

- 2) Practice letter names and sounds.

3) Practice writing uppercase and lowercase letters. Try writing your name with an uppercase letter first followed by lowercase letters.

- 4) Websites for literacy practice: Reading Websites
- 5) Play a rhyming game!! Here's a game you can play anywhere! One person chooses a word and says, *I challenge you to think of as many rhymes as you can for "cat"* (or any word). And the next player says as many words as they can that rhyme. Players keep count or go around

the circle and have everyone say a word that rhymes until someone can't think of one!

- 6) Practice a few sight words: <u>Kindergarten Sight Words</u> and <u>Sight Word</u>
 Activities
- 7) On a rainy day, select an activity from the literacy choice board!

Motor Skills

- Zip, tie, button and snap
- Practice shoe tying!
- Practice with scissors (cutting on lines)--holding properly
- Holding pencil correctly
- Use tweezers, tongs or utensils you can squeeze together (pick up shells, pebbles, etc.)
- Practice letters/numbers in shaving cream, sand table/tray
- Catching a ball
- Use Playdough, modeling clay, Model Magic, Kinetic Sand, sidewalk chalk
- Skip, hop, jump, hop, balance

Math

- 1) Sign up for a free <u>Freckle.com</u> or <u>Happy Numbers</u> account. Enjoy some math time for 10-15 minutes a day!
- 2) Practice:
 - Integrate oral counting into your daily movement or exercise routine.

- Create a sidewalk chalk "hopscotch" on your driveway. If numbers are too challenging, use shapes or colors in your blocks!
- Use math words to describe size and shape: smaller/larger, more/less, longer/shorter...
- Find and name shapes all around you!
- 3) On a rainy day, select an activity from the math choice board!
