1. Paper size A4; margins 2.54 cm (1 inch) on all sides; Times New Roman 12 pt; single spacing; justified alignment.
2. The paper is written in English with the structure: Title, Authors Identity (name, school, e-mail), Abstract, Introduction, Basic Theory, Research Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, References.
3. The maximum length of the paper is 10 pages, including tables, figures, and references.
4. Delete all instruction texts (grey italic) before submitting the paper.
