Mounted on a 0.75" deep wood frame, it can be hung as is on built-in hangers or framed later.




Tote Bag - \$15

The Design



Sylvie shares this about her design:

I felt inspired by the artwork after creating the Epiphany banner presentation.

- The wine in the chalice represents the blood of Jesus Christ which was shed for us
- Next to that are green rows in a vineyard
- The heart is the love that we have for Jesus as an individual and as a community, and that he has for us
- The tea cups represent fellowship when we get together for coffee after church, during potlucks, or bible study there is always coffee or tea to enjoy
- The dove represents peace and the Holy Spirit and family: there is a dove resting with a heart on her chest and her mate flying to the nest to help feed their young chicks
- The wheat represents the body of Jesus Christ which we break during Communion
- The circle around 25 years can represent God's eternal love for us
- The logo appears in white in the bottom right hand corner
