November Highlights



- Thank you to families who donated food and water for the Chamber Choir trip to SWU for the Fall Choral Classic. The students appreciated the support, especially the water!
- The Board was pleased to award scholarships for the first time for the New Orleans trip. The scholarships would not have been possible without generous donations from our members and their matching grants from companies like Microsoft and Boeing.

Trip Fundraising

We are officially in full swing on trip fundraising. Funds raised by students will be allocated into an account for a future trip. Vocal Jazz students may be fundraising for the April trip, but other students can start fundraising for any other future trip. Current opportunities:

Sale of Chukar Cherries. Students keep 100% of the profit. Students have forms they can use to collect orders (with check payment) and we have circulated a link for students to use to allow electronic payment (e-payment fees may slightly reduce profit margins). Be sure your student reminds their contacts to enter the student's name on the form so they get credit.

COMPETITION: The Equos Treble Choir and the Chamber Choir will be competing head to head for Chukar Cherries sales this week. The class to sell the most (by \$\$) will have a doughnut party supplied by the Boosters. Competition is for sales made between November 27 and December 1.

REMINDER: All physical order forms and checks must be turned in to Mr. Fitzgerald in class on Friday, December 1.

- Corporate Sponsorships. We are always accepting corporate sponsorships. Students retain 100% of the profit in their account.
 Minimum profit is \$150 per ad. See Mr. Fitzgerald if you'd like a brochure, but all information is at the link above as well.
- <u>Direct Donations</u>. If students would like to request donations to their trip
 account in lieu of other holiday gifts this year, or do a campaign for family
 to help fund their trip (like a gofundme), they can use this link to solicit
 those donations. The wording on the form currently mentions the Vocal



Jazz trip, however all donations for any student through this form will be credited accordingly.

More trip fundraising plans:

- Holiday Camp on hold. We had been working on a plan to host a holiday camp, but with only three weeks until the planned date and no affordable location, we have decided to table that idea. Instead we will begin our summer camp planning at our December meeting.
- Clothing Drive. We are kicking off an aggressive campaign to collect donations for a used clothing drive. We can get paid by the pound for gently used clothing and housewares. More information should come out this week, but we are going to need a lot of support from our choir families to encourage the community to clean out closets over the holidays and drop off items in early January. We are working on a system to track the contributions of students and their families so that the money can be credited to their accounts.

Students should have everything they need to participate in current opportunities.
