

Honors Geography First Term Culture Projects

Culture Project (50 pts)

Part 1

Option #1: Attend an activity or gathering of another culture other than your own.

- For Example: The India Fest or the Native Indian Festival up at Sundance

OR

Option #2: Have someone come into your home and provide a cultural experience.

- For Example: Have someone, who has spent at least one year in another country or Culture, come into your home and put on a Cultural Activity. Have them make food, show you pictures, dress up in the traditional clothes, explain the lifestyle, traditions, beliefs and the popular pastimes of the Culture.



Requirements:

- It has to be a culture that you don't already know a lot about.
- It needs to be an activity that you have attended during this school term.
- The activity or gathering must include more than just eating that culture's food.
- It cannot be an immediate family member.
- There needs to be displays, traditional activities, and demonstrations that depict that culture's religion, language, traditions, pastimes, and way of life.

Part 2

Write up a description of your experience. Label each section of the paper.

-Your paper should include the following:

Section 1: A description of what you saw and did. (Merely going to a place, looking around and leaving will not earn you full credit.)

Section 2: Explain what you learned about their food, their traditions, their beliefs or religion, and their everyday way of life.

Section 3: Tell me what you thought of the Culture. (Did you like it, would you like to live there? What would you have a hard time with?)

- Length: 2-3 pages typed, double-spaced, no larger than 12 point font.
