**Principals' Report – Scott Laman and Taryn Baker**

- Final Exam Schedule will be 1-3-3 with early release on the last two days at the end of semester. Details will be shared in the Firebird news.
- Crosswalk Safety Meetings Update – Lakota district and West building administration are listening and working toward increased safety practices.
- PSAT will take place during the school day next year and teachers will be utilized to help administer it.
- Mr. Laman shared Lakota West's Action Plan Building Goals. PBIS will be starting with teachers now and student recognition will begin next semester with a special lunch and gift of Lakota West gear to students nominated by the staff. Mr. Laman asked for support of this PBIS initiative. PBIS Recognition of Pillars: AIR – Authenticity, Investments, Relationships
- Lakota District Star Rating (out of 5 stars) – we got 4.5 stars, district increased its overall rating by 1 star, moving from 3.5 to 4.5 stars, which exceeds state standards. Our state rank improved from 330 to 111. Progress Rating – how does the teacher grow an individual student (Value Added) All subgroups were positive. Performance Index (PI). College, Career, Workforce, Military (CCWM) Readiness Component measures how well-prepared Ohio's students are for all future opportunities. Lakota increased by 21%. Strategic programmatic changes continue to increase our readiness data.
