 - All event organisers are invited to apply, and submissions will be reviewed by the LCAW Secretariat in accordance with their terms and conditions.
 - This year they are introducing a new portal-based system for event hosts. The portal will provide you with a single place to draft/save your events, submit them for review, keep track of their status and request changes.
