Review Last Meeting Minutes

Action items

- Purchase of movie license
- A lot of students using the new 4 Square- purchase more?
  - Coloured in- more expensive
  - Approx \$1700 to get all 3 painted
  - Purchase approved
  - Sand is damaging the current 4 Squares- important to continue to clean the sand, otherwise, it may not be worth the investment
  - Nicole to discuss with the painting company- Shouldn't be chipping. Could the company do free touch ups?
- Picnic tables
  - Hexagon tables- fit 6 students
    - \$1172 each
    - \$1120- purchase 3+
    - Shipping not included
  - Super Saver- seats 8
    - \$1300 each
    - Includes shipping
  - Picnic tables will need to be anchored/chained to a tree
    - Need to buy chains as well to anchor
    - Concrete needed depending on location
  - Keep all tables together so that classes could work at them
  - Approved 3 Super Saver picnic tables
- Gaga Ball pit
  - Brackets (8)- \$600 with shipping
  - Still need to pay for wood & screws
  - Lisa found an alternate DIY plan that would cost \$1162
  - DIY hinges appear sharper, might be best to invest in the proper brackets

- o Concerns with arson? Alternative could be to use composite deck boards
- o Will need to include the cost of screenings
- o Next steps:
  - Continue to cost out price options
  - Revisit in the spring
- Additional Tether Ball?
  - o Nicole to investigate cost?
  - o 1 for Intermediate, 1 for Junior/Primary
- Do we want to proceed with shade structure?
  - o Staff interested in a new sign out front, or new LED panels
    - Current sign is difficult to change
    - Would be a longterm project
    - May be expensive to run power to the sign
    - Solar option?
    - Nicole to explore price options

  - o Artech- fastest response
    - Could drop off sample sizes
    - Could hang sizes in the window so parents could compare
    - Minimum 24 pieces
    - Zip Hoodies- \$29.95
    - Pullover hoodies- \$24.95
    - Long sleeve t-shirts- \$12.95
    - Short sleeve t-shirts- \$8.95
    - Sweat pants- \$17.95
    - \*\*Quote: smaller "A" crest in green or black with white logo for all 5 options\*\*
  - o Instant Imprints- Barrie
    - Difficulty in numbers as we couldn't provide a range
    - Could add "Voyageurs" across the back with the logo as a small crest on front
  - o Kutting Edge- unable to connect
  - o

  - o We choose a home game from schedule
  - o Confirm numbers up to 1-2 weeks before game
  - o Pre-sale tickets for \$21 each (regular face value is \$23.50-\$26.00)
  - o Make \$4-6 per ticket depending on how many are sold
  - o Sell 2 Colts player and Charlie Horse mascot costume to the school
  - o Option to sing nation anthem
  - o School logo displayed through the game

- o Collect our cheque on game night or have it mailed to the school
- o Investigate digital tickets
- o Are vaccinations required?
- o Tickets could be sent home with students
- o Pick a weekend day after Christmas
- o Jan 15<sup>th</sup> vs. North Bay
- Bradford Greenhouses Poinsettia Fundraiser
  - o We would pay Bradford Greenhouses- could we accept e-transfers or payment through School-Day
  - o Conflict: can't exchange items at the school
  - o Would curbside pickup be allowed at the school?
  - o Too short of turn around time
